

RESOLUTION NO. 75-43
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is desirous of accepting the offer of the Bureau of Indian Affairs for Enforcement Personnel for the Olympia positions, and

WHEREAS, this offer was made and discussed in the office of S. A. Lozar on April 29, 1975, at which time S. A. Lozar, Superintendent, Western Washington Agency; John Bushman, Enforcement, Western Washington Agency; Blanchard Matte, Business Manager, Lower Elwa; Gary Peterson, Secretary, Skokomish Tribal Council; Bill Smith, Chairman, Skokomish Tribal Council; and Calvin J. Peters, Chairman, Squaxin Island Tribal Council were present, and

WHEREAS, the only concern mentioned was that the Bureau of Indian Affairs had already hired an individual for one position.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does accept the Bureau of Indian Affairs Olympia Enforcement personal and will take into consideration the concern regarding the previous hiring, by the Western Washington Agency of one staff position.

CERTIFICATION

The Foregoing Resolution was adopted at a regular meeting of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council held on May 20, 1975, at which time a quorum of Council Members were present and was passed by a vote of 4 for and 0 against.
