


RESOLUTION NO. 75-44 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is a member in good standing with the Small Tribes Organization of Western Washington, and

WHEREAS, this organization has for several years prioritized and worked toward a goal of land acquisition for member Tribes which would allow economic development within these Tribes, provide a livelihood for Tribal Members and benefit all society, and

WHEREAS, such development is not possible without land.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does unanimously support the land acquisition proposals submitted by Mr. Gary Peterson, Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Small Tribes Organization of Western Washington, presented to the Senate and House Appropriations Committee, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does strongly urge that this matter be seriously considered and everything within your powers done to satisfy the pressing need of land.

CERTIFICATION

The Foregoing Resolution was adopted at a regular meeting of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council, held on June 2, 1975, at which time a quorum of Council Members were present and was passed by a vote of 3 for and 0 against.
