RESOLUTION No. 75-49
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965, and

WHEREAS, Squaxin Island Tribe is desirous of entering into an anadromous and nonanadromous shellfish species protection contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, under Rights Protection, and


WHEREAS, such proposed contract has been reviewed and approved by the Squaxin Island Tribal Council,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, Squaxin Island Tribal Council does approve the entering into of a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the management of anadromous and nonanadromous fish and shellfish species protection, under Rights Protection.




CERTIFICATION"
