

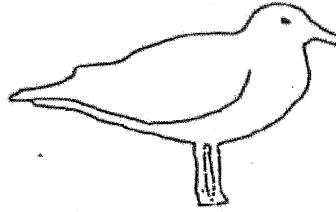

## RESOLUTION NO. 75-51 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is desirous of entering into a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the implementation of Judge Doldt's decision in U. S. vs. Washington, to cover funding of Law Enforcement, and

WHEREAS, such proposed contract has been reviewed and approved by the Squaxin Island Tribal Council,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does approve the entering into of a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs in accordance with Judge Doldt's mandate in U. S. vs. Washington, for law enforcement.


