WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is desirous of participating in the 1976 Small Tribes Organization of Western Washington - ONAP Mini-Grant Program, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has reviewed the proposed program and budget and find it to be in accordance with the Squaxin Island Tribe's Administrative goals and objectives, and


WHEREAS, a principle investigator and designer must be assigned.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby appoint Business Manager Bryan A. Johnson as principle investigator with all responsibility and authority therein, and


