

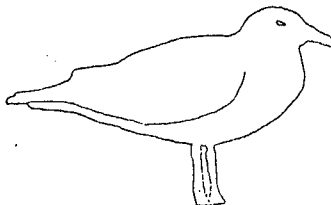

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe wishes to renew our membership with the National Congress of American Indians; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe meets all requirements for Tribal Membership pursuant to the Constitutions of NCAI (Article II, Sec. 1, b);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council of the Squaxin Island Tribe hereby authorizes the Chairman, Calvin J. Peters of the Tribe, to join the National Congress of American Indians; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Tribal funds in the amount of \$35.55 based on the Tribal Membership dues schedule of the NCAI By-Laws (Article III, Sec. 1, b), are authorized to be paid for such Tribal Membership; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that based on membership of 211, as verified by Tribal records, the Tribe shall have 100 votes according to the NCAI Constitution (Article IV, Sec. 3); and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that pursuant to Article V, Sec. 2 of the Constitution, the Tribe designates Mr. Calvin J. Peters who is a member of NCAI in good standing, to be its official representative to NCAI, and designates Sally Ann Norman also an individual member of NCAI in good standing, to be the alternate representative.

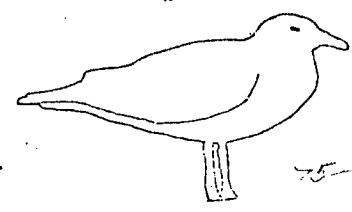

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe wishes to renew our membership with the National Congress of American Indians; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe meet: all requirements for Tribal Membership pursuant to the Constitutions of NCAI (Article II, Sec. 1, b);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED; that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council of the Squaxin Island Tribe hereby authorizes the Chairman, Calvin J. Peters of the Tribe to join the National Congress of American Indians; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Tribal funds in the amount of ~~335.55~~ based on the Tribal Membership dues schedule of the NCAI By-Laws (Article III, Sec. 1, b), are authorized to be paid for such Tribal Membership ~~and~~ (see attached letter) and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that based on membership of 211, as verified by Tribal records, the Tribe shall have 100 votes according to the NCAI Constitution (Article IV, Sec. 3); and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that pursuant to Article 7, Sec. 2 of the Constitution, the Tribe designates Mr. Calvin J. Peters who is a member of NCAI in good standing, to be its official representative to NCAI, and designates Sally Ann Norman also an individual member of NCAI in good standing, to be the alternate representative.


