

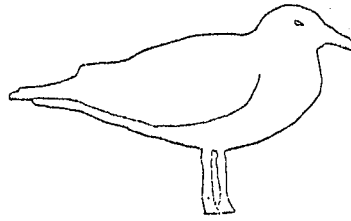

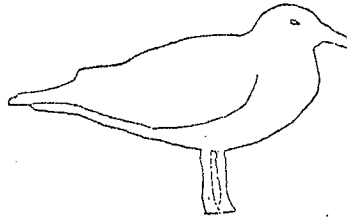

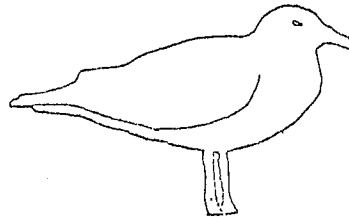

SUBJECT: Squaxin Island Tribal Council Resolution 76-1

Dear Mr. Briscoe:

Attached please find Squaxin Island Tribal Council Resolution 76-1 concerning the taking into trust of land off-reservation for Squaxin housing.

At a meeting in Yelm, Washington, at which time representatives from the Squaxin Island, Nisqually, and Skokomish Tribes were present, you indicated your ability to take into trust off-reservation fee land when need and intent were indicated. It is our belief that subject resolution indicates the intent and need.

It is common knowledge that the progress and welfare of the Squaxin Island Tribal peoples has in the past been severely hampered due to our land situation. The land described within subject resolution lies within 1 mile of the Squaxin Island Tribal Center. It is imperative if Squaxin Island is to receive housing that this land be taken into trust. We feel a great deal of consideration has been given this location and have received indications by the various agencies involved with the Southern Puget Sound Inter-Tribal Housing Authority that this location meets HUD criteria.

There are a great number of steps that have yet to be taken to receive site approval and permanent allocation of these units from the Southern Puget Sound Inter-Tribal Housing Authority to Squaxin Island; however, nothing more can be done until we are able to notify the various agencies that this land in fact will be taken into trust.
