

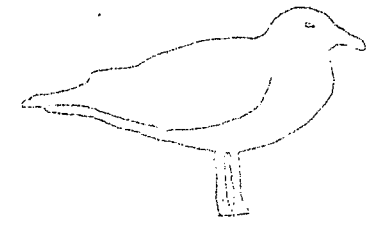

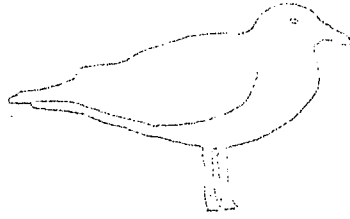

RESOLUTION NO. 76-8
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Nation on July 9, 1965, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe has an ongoing Sea Farms Project (Salmon and Oyster Farming), and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe has, in the past, received funding through the Economic Development Administration for the Squaxin Sea Farms Project (Salmon Farming), and

WHEREAS, assistance through the Economic Development Administration for the Oyster Farming portion of the Squaxin Sea Farms Project has previously been hindered by the Maritime and Maritime Logistics Study, and

WHEREAS, all properties of the Squaxin Sea Farm Project are now in trust status, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council desires more intensive deliberation and additional research and technical assistance to complete a revised public works program, and


WHEREAS, the success of the Squaxin Sea Farm Project (Salmon and Oyster Farming) is severely dependent upon the modification and addition of the facilities provided with a the revised public works program.


NOW WHEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council hereby authorize the submission of a Maritime Program to the Department for Economic Development Administration - Maritime Program proposal.


IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council hereby authorize the submission of the Squaxin public works program to the Department for Economic Development Administration.
