

WESREAS, the Squard Teland Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squard Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squard Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965, and

WHERLIS, the Squakin Island Tribe is a member in good standing with the Small Indias Organization of Western Washington, and

EMERICS, the Squamin Island Tribe considers the issues present before the Minth Circuit Court of Appeals in Yakima Indian Trips of Yakima Co., at al. to be of fundamental importance to tribes in State of Wakington; and

UKEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council would like to support the agreements, in that case, that Washington has never validly appropriate introduction through Public Law 83-280 over Reservation Tribes and that Washington's retrocessions of jurisdiction over the Quinsula Lan Mation and Suquamish Tribes were retrocessions of votal jurisdiction.
