SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 765-

RESOLUTION APPROVING APPLICATION FOR PRELIMINARY LOAN FOR LOW-RENT PUBLIC HOUSING.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of this locality to eliminate substandard and other inadequate housing, to prevent the spread of slums and blight, and to realize as soon as feasible the goal of a decent home in suitable living environment for all of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the United States Housing Act of 1937, as amended, the United States of America, acting through the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development (herein called the "Government"), is authorized to provide financial assistance to local public housing agencies for undertaking and carrying out preliminary planning of low-rent housing projects that will assist in meeting this goal; and

WHEREAS, the Act provides that there shall be local determination of need for low-rent housing to meet needs not being adequately met by private enterprise and that the Government shall not make any contract with a public housing agency for preliminary loans for surveys and planning in respect to any low-rent housing projects unless the governing body of the locality involved has by resolution approved the application of the public housing agency for such preliminary loan; and

WHEREAS, the Southern Puget Sound Inter-Tribal Housing Authority (herein called the "Local Authority") is a public housing agency and is applying to the Government for a preliminary loan to cover the costs of surveys and planning in connection with the development of low-rent housing;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Tribal Council Reservation of the Squaxin Island of the Squaxin Island Indian as follows;

- 1. That there exists in the Squaxin Island Indian a need for such low-rent Reservation of Squaxin Island Tribe housing which is not being met by private enterprise;
- 2. That the application of the Local Authority to the Government for a preliminiary loan in an amount not to exceed \$29,000.00 for surveys and planning in connection with low-rent housing projects of not to exceed ____ dwelling units is hereby approved; approximately 58
- 3. That the Squaxin Island Tribal Council reviewed the application and, as there is no approved Housing Assistance Plan for this tribe, there is a need for the housing assistance applied for taking into consideration any State or Tribal housing plans, and that there is or will be availabe in the area public facilities and services adequate to serve the proposed housing.

CERTIFICATION

The foregoing Resolution was adopted at a regular meeting of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council, held on September 1, 1976, at which time a quorum of Council Members were present and was passed by a vote of 4 for and against.
