RESOLUTION NO. 77-67

of the

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the governing body of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation by authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965, and


WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe has a duly appointed representative to the Puget Sound Health Board to make known the health needs of the Squaxin Island Tribe and has been delegated the authority and responsibility to participate in decisions, development, and implementation of Indian Health Service policies, and;


WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is fully supportive of the Puget Sound Health Board's resolution No. 77-205 requesting Indian Health Service to develop and to provide a specialized training program in health planning and health program management to the Puget Sound Service Unit tribes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribe does hereby authorize the Puget Sound Health Board to enter into a 638 grant contract with Indian Health Service to provide the said health administrative training program to the Puget Sound Service Unit tribes.
