Resolution No. 77-

of the

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with the responsibility of providing for the overall health, education and welfare of its tribal members, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has provided for the overall welfare of its members in a number of ways including economic development, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has now, an on-going fisheries enhancement project with its future potential as yet undetermined, and

WHEREAS, this Squaxin Island Tribal enterprise specifically addresses the release of anadromous smolts from the Tribal pen rearing facility for returning adult recapture (i.e., ocean ranching), and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is considering an expansion of this program but a comprehensive tagging study must first be initiated to determine its future economic potential, and


WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is desirous of entering into an agreement with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the specific purpose of securing technical assistance funds to initiate a Tagging and Recovery Study to determine the economic feasibility of program expansion, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council hereby requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs enter into a contract to provide technical assistance funds to the Squaxin Island Tribe for the purpose of initiating a "Fish Tagging and Recovery Study".
