## RESOLUTION NO. 79-19 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the establishment of the Squaxin Island Tribal Court; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has expressed its desire to avail itself of the services of the Northwest Intertribal Court System when said services become available in Resolutions 78-21 and 78-53; and


WHEREAS, the Steering Committee of the Northwest Intertribal Court Systems Board has interviewed candidates for the position of judge, and has hired Mary T. Turgeon, an enrolled member of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe and a graduate of the University of Minnesota Law School, to perform the services of Judge of the Northwest Intertribal Court System; and

WHEREAS, under the Emergency Court Procedures Ordinance of the Squaxin Island Tribe at Sections I (5) and (6), the Tribal Council may appoint a qualified person to serve as Tribal Judge;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Mary T. Turgeon is hereby appointed Squaxin Island Tribal Judge, for a period of one year from the date of enactment of this Resolution.


### CERTIFICATION
