RESOLUTION NO. 79-36  
of the  
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with the responsibility of managing the natural resources of the Squaxin Island Tribe, and that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has identified the need for the interplanting of the timber resource upon a 55 (fifty-five) acre parcel of Tribal land within the boundaries of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has the authority under Public Law 93-638 to enter into contracts with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for programs and services beneficial to the Squaxin Island Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does require Forestry Development funds to be utilized for the interplanting of the aforementioned 55 (fifty-five) acres of land within the boundaries of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby request the Bureau of Indian Affairs enter into a Public Law 93-638 contract with the Squaxin Island Tribe for the interplanting of 55 (fifty-five) acres of land within the boundaries of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation.






