WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is a member of the Southern Puget Sound Inter-tribal Planning Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe, has in the past, participated in the Indian Action Team Program through the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Division of Indian Technical Assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe has seen major progress through Indian Action Program activities and participation; and


WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe has established a need for further participation in this program; and




