RESOLUTION NO. 80-5 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with the overall health, education and welfare of its' Tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the operation of an energy assistance program is necessary to aid the low-income and elderly families of the Tribal service population; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is a member of the Southern Puget Sound Intertribal Planning Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is aware and has, through its board representative, participated in the development of the Community Services Administration, Energy Assistance proposal; and



WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe has insufficient funds to support the operation of an energy assistance program; and


