RESOLUTION NO. 80- //  
of the  
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has enacted Resolution No. 79-40 promulgating the Squaxin Island Liquor Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council wishes to amend the Tribal Liquor Ordinance to provide that Squaxin Island itself continues to be closed to the possession, consumption or sale of intoxicating beverages;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Liquor Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1.2 shall read, in part:


The Squaxin Island Tribe has decided to open the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation, except for Squaxin Island itself, to the possession, consumption, and sale of liquor.....
