RESOLUTION NO. 80-13
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of The Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with the responsibility of the overall health, education and welfare of its members; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council finds that in order to provide for the most needs of its members and for the economic development of the Tribe that it is imperative that community services facilities be provided; and

WHEREAS, land is available for the construction of a community services facility; and

WHEREAS, a community services facility is, after housing, been deemed the most serious membership need; and

WHEREAS, the only means for obtaining funding for the community services facility is through the Community Development Block Grant Program of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, there has been adequate Tribal participation as required by the Community Development Block Grant regulations, certification of which is hereby given; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council approves the above and authorizes the submission of a pre-application to Housing and Urban Development for funding of a community services facility.


C E R T I F I C A T I O N
