## RESOLUTION NO. 80-65 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and the By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965, and

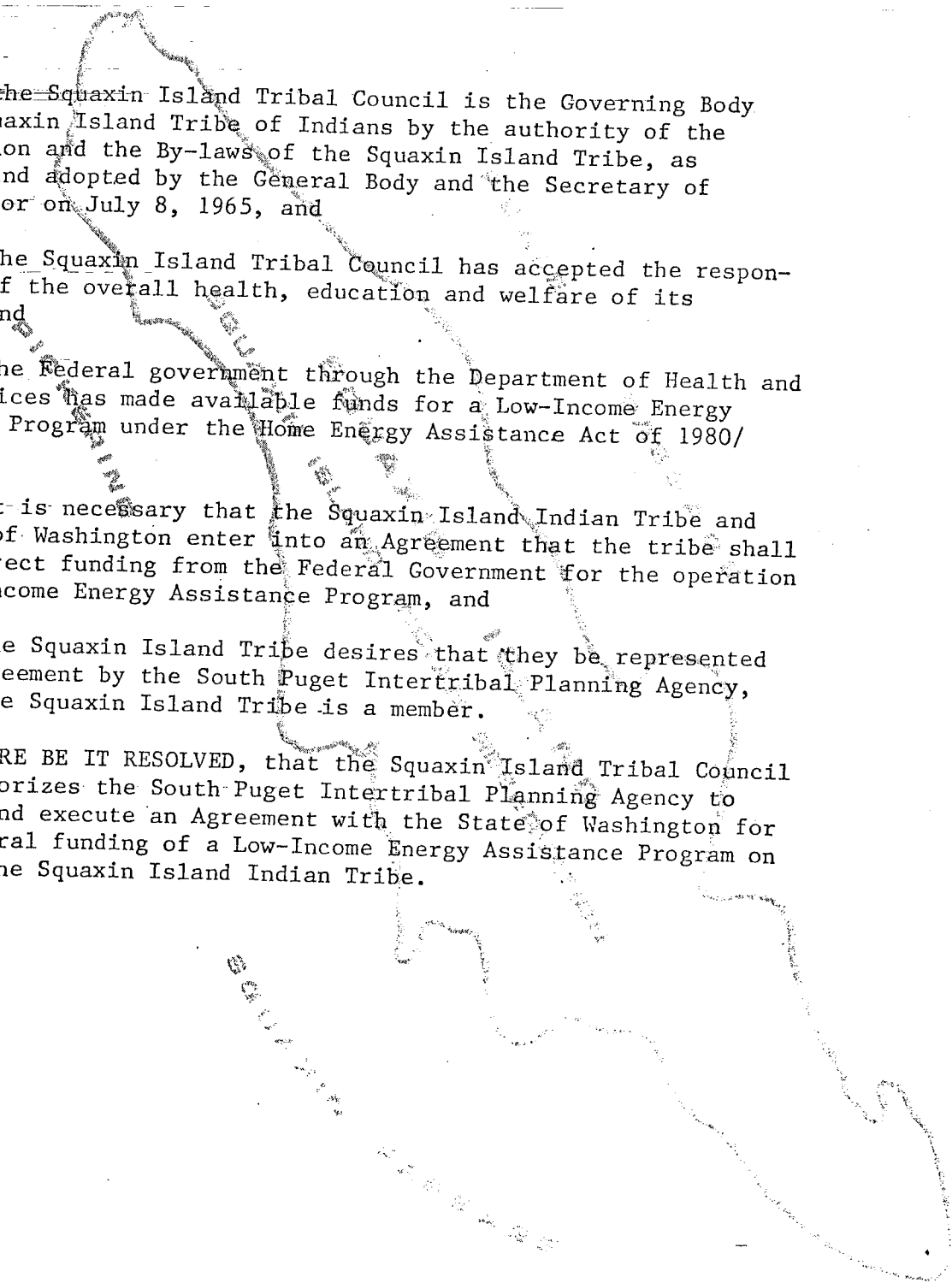
WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has accepted the responsibility of the overall health, education and welfare of its members, and

WHEREAS, the Federal government through the Department of Health and Human Services has made available funds for a Low-Income Energy Assistance Program under the Home Energy Assistance Act of 1980/81, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe and the State of Washington enter into an Agreement that the tribe shall receive direct funding from the Federal Government for the operation of a Low-Income Energy Assistance Program, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe desires that they be represented in this Agreement by the South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency, of which the Squaxin Island Tribe is a member.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council hereby authorizes the South Puget Intertribal Planning Agency to negotiate and execute an Agreement with the State of Washington for direct federal funding of a Low-Income Energy Assistance Program on behalf of the Squaxin Island Indian Tribe.




CERTIFICATION
