## RESOLUTION NO. 81-05 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with the responsibility of providing for the overall health, education and welfare of its Tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council in keeping with this responsibility is seeking to provide: a system for licensing Indian foster and adoptive homes; family assistance, including counseling, daycare, afterschool care, employment, and recreation care; the employment of a trained person to assist the Tribal Court in the disposition of domestic relations and child welfare matters; education and training of Indians in skills relating to child and family assistance and service programs; and guidance, legal representation, and advice to Indian families involved in Tribal, State or Federal child custody proceedings; and


WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has the authority under Title II of the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978 (Public Law 95-608) to enter into grants with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for programs and services benefiting members of the Squaxin Island Tribe.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council hereby submit a project grant application as authorized by Public Law 95-608, to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for a Indian Child and Family Service Program; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council designates the Tribal Chairman; and/or the Tribal Administrative Director are authorized to negotiate, amend, and execute this grant with the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
