RESOLUTION NO. 81-9 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with the responsibility of providing for the overall health, education, and welfare of its Tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council, in keeping with this responsibility, is seeking to provide in-house social services to its Tribal members; and

WHEREAS, this counselor shall provide referral and liaison services, parenting skills classes/counseling, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has the authority under Public Law 93-638 to enter into contracts with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for programs and services benefiting members of the Squaxin Island Tribe

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council hereby requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs enter into a Public Law 93-638 contract with the Squaxin Island Tribe to provide social services which shall commence on April 1, 1981 and shall terminate on September 30, 1981.


