WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the Authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior, on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with the responsibility of insuring the overall social, health and welfare development of its members; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has directed that the Bureau of Indian Affairs provide a Housing Improvement Program for members of its service population; and

WHEREAS, the Olympic Peninsula Agency is initiating a new policy in FY '81 of allocating H.I.P. money to the most needy applicants submitted by Tribes; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council requests the BIA to determine costs by priority and in cooperation with the applicant.


## CERTIFICATION


The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Squaxin Island Tribal Council at a regular meeting held on this 8th day of July, 1981, at which




