RESOLUTION NO. 81 - 57
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe has common fishing areas with the Puyallup Indian Nation; and

WHEREAS, cross enforcement commissions will provide Joint Enforcement Patrols for the protection of all members and the enforcement of fishing ordinances; and


WHEREAS, any offending fishermen will be cited into their respective tribal courts; and

WHEREAS, each tribe will appoint an interim police officer to appear, in place of citing officer, at arraignments, with the citing officer appearing at trials and/or appeals;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council hereby resolves to obtain and provide cross enforcement commissions with the Puyallup Nation.
