RESOLUTION NO. 81-64
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is and Incorporator and member in good standing of the Western Washington Employment and Training Program (W.E.I.E.T.P.) known as the CETA Consortium.


WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has appointed Calvin J. Peters as first delegate to the CETA consortium and Bryan A. Johnson as alternate delegate.

WHEREAS, Lorna Gouin has been appointed as Technical Advisor to the Squaxin Island delegation and has indicated a continuing interest in the CETA operation.


