WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is responsible for protecting the rights of all members of the Squaxin Island Tribe including but not limited to, Natural Resources, Water Resources and Sovereign Treaty Rights set out in U.S. vs Washington (Boldt Decision): and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is concerned with the Northwest Indian Fish Commission's Administration:

1. Working with a projected deficit (\$25,000).
2. Possibly earmarking Phase II funds to cover this projected deficit.
3. Inflated salary Budget.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council objects to the F.Y. 1983 recontract proposal of the Northwest Indian Fish Commission for the operation of the Fisheries Resource Management Program until the following is implemented to the approval of the Tribes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council requests an audit be conducted by the Bureau of Indian Affairs to see why there should be a projected deficit, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council requests that the five Treaty Area Commissioners conduct a review of the Constitution and By-laws of the Northwest Indian Fish Commission and the job descriptions of the key personnel for the purpose of putting limitations on decision making by the Administration concerning policy and tribal issues, and that the Commissioners work with the Treaty Coordinators and their Case Area Tribes on all the above concerns.


