RESOLUTION NO. 82-49
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council as the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe provides for the creation, administration and enforcement of Tribal Laws; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has provided for the establishment of Squaxin Island Tribal Court to assist the Council in enforcing its laws, Resolution 78-40, and the Squaxin Island Emergency Court Procedures Ordinance to set forth the rules of procedure for that Court; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is necessary to amend that Ordinance in the following respects:

- Contempt of Court
- Limitation of Prosecutions
- Pretrial Motions
- Degree Offenses--Convictions of Lesser Offence
- Extraterritorial Fresh Pursuit
- Extraterritorial Transport in Custody;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby amend the Squaxin Island Emergency Court Procedures Ordinance in the manner attached: Title, I Administrative Rules, Rule K 2, VI Rules of Criminal Procedure A, O, X.2, X.3, D1, AA.
