WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and


WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe has an ongoing need to protect the water resources of Squaxin Island, other tribal properties, those streams which are critical to the fisheries resource in the Tribe's usual and accustomed fishing areas, and to deal with other tribal needs vis-a-vis water resources;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribe requests a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant to Public Law 93-638 in the amount of \$ 40,275 plus indirect cost to meet the Tribe's need for water resource protection and hydrologic information.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council designates the Tribal Chairman or Tribal Administrative Director, as the tribal officials to further pursue, negotiate, amend and execute this contract. The proposed term of this contract is from October 1, 1983 through September 30, 1984.
