RESOLUTION NO. 83-59
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with the overall care and development of its members; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is intent upon providing Tribal Members and their families with every opportunity for growth and development; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council recognizes the important role of education in the realization of individual potential of Tribal Members and their children; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does herein grant the authority of this resolution to expire on September 30, 1984; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council designates the proposed term of this contract to be from December 1, 1983 through September 30, 1984; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does herein authorize the sub-mission of this proposal for Title IV Part C, funding for an education assistance program, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Tribal Chairman or Tribal Vice Chairman to act as the official Tribal representative for the purpose of executing, negotiating and/or amending this Title IV Education Contract.


