WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that the sale of Timber from Allotments 12 and 21 is in the best interest of the landowners and the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Timber sale is consistent with the Forest Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the property owners have granted powers of Attorney to the Tribe for the purpose of conducting this timber sale;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council requests the issuance of Special Allotment Timber Cutting Permit by Bureau of Indian Affairs for the harvest of Timber from Allotments 12 and 21 of the Squaxin Island reservation.


