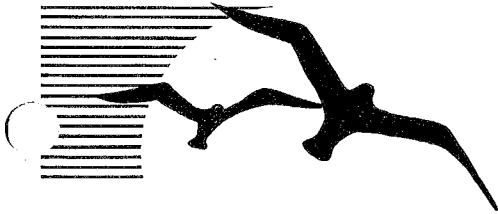

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Construction and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council provides for the creation, administration and enforcement of Tribal Laws; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council in keeping with this responsibility is seeking to promote and upgrade a more efficient enforcement of Tribal Laws, the protection of Tribal Members and their property and Natural Resources of the Tribe.

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has identified a need to establish a Law and Order Committee to assist them in achieving the aforementioned responsibilities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby appoint the following to serve in the capacity of advising the Council and Chief as the Law and Order Committee:

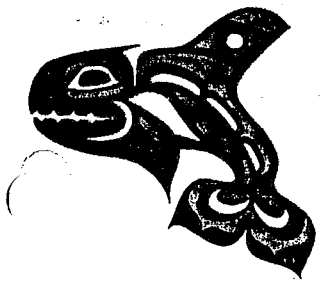
