### RESOLUTION NO.84-39 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General body and the Secretary of Interior on July 8, 1965, and

WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health, and economic welfare of its members, and

WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Tribal Council seeks to operate an Adult Vocational Training Program in the areas of Oyster Mariculture and Basic Carpentry, combining classroom and on-the-job training, and

WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Tribal Council intends to enter into a P.L. 93-638 Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for funds with which to operate this AVT program,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the submission of this application and the execution of a P.L. 93-638 contract for an Adult Vocational Training Program and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the term of ~~this contract~~ shall be from October 1, 1984 to September 30, 1985, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, and Tribal Manager to act as its official representative for this contract, with full authority to negotiate and execute all contract documents and any amendments thereto, and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That this authority shall be for the duration of the Contract.
