RESOLUTION NO. 85-45 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and


WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council, by its Resolution Number 85-25, approved the submission of an application for a direct loan of \$65,000 from the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and

WHEREAS, this loan has been approved by the Bureau of Indian Affairs on the condition that the Squaxin Island Tribe accepts that the sale price is excessively over the appraisal done by the Bureau of Indian Affairs,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council hereby accepts that the sale price is excessively over the appraisal.
