RESOLUTION NO. 85-61
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with the responsibility of providing for the overall health, education and welfare of it's Tribal Members; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council supports the Puget Sound Health Board and desires that it continue functioning; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been informed that funding at the previous level is no longer available for the Puget Sound Health Board; and

WHEREAS, the Puget Sound Service Unit of Indian Health Service has offered a part time clerk with a salary of \$10,480 per year to continue some of the services of the PSHB; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council feels a part time clerk is not adequate to do the major PSHB functions; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribe supports a contract that allows \$16,000 salary plus fringe and travel for a full time clerk position.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council recommends that this contract be under the Puyallup Tribe.
