RESOLUTION NO. 85-69
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe by authority of the Constitution and ByLaws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body, and by the Secretary of Interior on July 8, 1965, and

WHEREAS, in Section 1102 (a) of Public Law 95-561 the Secretary of the Interior is instructed to develop alternative methods for the equitable distribution of Johnson O'Malley program supplement funds, and

WHEREAS, in Section 1102 (b) of Public Law 95-561 the Secretary of the Interior is instructed to conduct a vote by tribes and Alaskan villages on a formula which the majority of the Tribes determine through their vote to be the most equitable, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has reviewed and considered the descriptions of the seven distribution formulas to be voted upon,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that on the 12th day of December, 1985, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council chose Formula Option 4, by a vote of 4 for, and 0 against, with 0 abstentions.
