WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health and economic well being of its members, and



WHEREAS, after discussion and consensus was reached, the Tribal Council voted submit an economic development project as the first priority and a Community Facility as a second priority project for 1986.


