## SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 86-6

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has the responsibility to care for and protect the members of the Tribal Community, the Council has enacted a Law and Order Code to do so on January 16, 1980; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council deems it necessary to amend the Law and Order Code in order to carry out that responsibility in the best possible manner.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does here-by amend the Squaxin Island Law and Order Code, Section 27.1, <u>Contributing</u> to the Delinquency of a <u>Minor</u>, to read:

(1) In a case where a child is a youth-in-need-of-care or a youth offender under the Squaxin Island <u>Law and Order Code</u>, the parent or legal guardian, or person having custody of the child, or any other person having custody of the child, or any other person who, by an act or omission, encourages, causes, or contributes to the child's dependancy or delinquency shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor.
