**RESOLUTION NO. 86- 8**  
**of the**  
**SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL**

**WHEREAS:** the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965, and

**WHEREAS:** the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has accepted the responsibility of the overall health, education and welfare of its tribal members; and

**WHEREAS:** the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has purchased a parcel of land known as the Arcadia Boat Ramp; and

**WHEREAS:** the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does intend to keep the boat ramp open to tribal members for access to Squaxin Island and Tribal fishing grounds, and to the public.

**WHEREAS:** the parcel of land is within the boundaries of the Squaxin Island Partial Land Consolidation Plan.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby request that the United States accept the title to the following described real property in trust for the Squaxin Island Tribe:

PARCEL 1

Lots 1,2,3,4,5 and 6, Block 13, Plat of the Town of Arkadia (Arcadia) as recorded in Volume 1 of Plats, page 6, records of Mason County, Washington.

TOGETHER WITH that portion of vacated alley adjoining said lots as described on resolution #61-82 and recorded under Auditor's File No. 406244.

PARCEL 2

Lots 5, 6, 7 and 8, Block 10, Plat of the Town of Arkadia (also known as the Plat of Arcadia), according to the recorded plat thereof in the office of the Auditor for said County and State, Volume 1 of Plats, page 6, records of Mason County, Washington.

TOGETHER WITH that portion of vacated alley adjoining said lots.

PARCEL 3


All that portion of an oysterland tract as conveyed by the State of Washington, to Louisa Williams and Adam Williams, dated September 2, 1903, under Application No. 2908, in front of part of Sections 21 and 28, Township 20 North, Range 2 West, W.M., in Mason County, Washington, according to the plat and field notes on file in the office of the Commissioner of Public Lands at Olympia, Washington, as per deed recorded in Volume 12 of Deeds, page 471, records of Mason County, Washington, together with Reversionary Rights acquired by Earl Malpass from the State of Washington under Application No. 11399 by deed dated September 7, 1948 and recorded October 4, 1948 in Volume 121 of Deeds, page 43, records of Mason County, Washington and lying within or adjacent to the boundaries of the following described property and lying above the line of mean low tide:

Graham Street as shown on the plat know as the Plan of the Town of Arkadia (otherwise know as Arcadia) and lying between the Northeasterly and Southwesterly lines of said Graham Street extended Southeasterly over and across said oysterland tract.
