RESOLUTION NO. 86-44 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, The Squaxin Island Tribal Council is charged with the welfare of the Squaxin Island Indian people.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribe opposes any change by Indian Health Service in the current methodology of establishing tribal indirect cost rates through the I. G. 's office.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribe supports the position developed by the Northwest Portland Area Indian Health Board on the issue of indirect cost rates.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council urges Indian Health Services to aggressively pursue Tribes' full indirect cost needs when seeking funding for P.L. 638 contracts with Indian Tribes under the Self-Determination Act.
