### SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

#### RESOLUTION NO. 86 - 45

**WHEREAS;** the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the governing body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the constitution and by-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the general body and the secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

**WHEREAS;** the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has the responsibility to care for and protect the members and resources of the tribal community, the council has enacted a fishing ordinance to do so; and

**WHEREAS;** the Tribal Council deems it necessary to amend the fishing ordinance in order to carry out the responsibility in the best possible manner,

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED;** that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby amend the Squaxin Island Fishing Ordinance to read as follows:

- ADD TO SECTION XXII. Violations and punishments Subsections A. (2)  
Class (A) Gross Misdemeanors (B) (ix)  
Participating in a tribal fishery while utilizing a boat, gear or equipment in violation of Section XXI of this ordinance.
- ADD TO SECTION XXII. Violations and punishments Subsection A. (3)  
Gross Misdemeanors (B) (ix) To wantonly waste or destroy food fish or shellfish.
- ADD TO SECTION XXII. Violations and punishments Subsection A. (3)  
Gross Misdemeanors (B) (x) Operating a fishing vessel while intoxicated.
- ADD A NEW SECTION XXI A. Waste of food fish or shellfish unlawful - It shall be a violation of this ordinance to wantonly waste or destroy steelhead, salmon, hardshell clams or oysters.
- ADD A NEW SECTION XXI. B. It shall be a violation of this ordinance to operate a fishing vessel while under influence of intoxicating liquor/drugs.

CHANGE SECTION XXII. A. (3) (b) (iv)


Participating in the Tribal Fishery while allowing a person to be on the fishing boat. Whose presence thereon is not authorized by this Ordinance.

TO READ: Participating in the tribal fishery while allowing a person, to assist in the fishery or be on the fishing boat, who is not authorized by this Ordinance.
