### **RESOLUTION NO. 87-2 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL**

**WHEREAS**, The Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

**WHEREAS**, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health and economic well being of its members; and

**WHEREAS**, alcohol and substance abuse is recognized as a serious problem for some tribal members; and

**WHEREAS**, the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1986 authorizes Indian Tribes to develop Tribal Action Plans and provides funding for the implementation of these plans.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council authorizes the development of a Tribal Action Plan, which at least meets federal standards, to address alcohol and substance abuse problems in the tribal community; and


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Tribal Manager is assigned the responsibility of coordinating the formation of a Tribal Coordinating Committee and acting as technical advisor to the committee and liason between the Council and the Committee during plan development.


