RESOLUTION NO. 87-11
of the
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is responsible for the health and welfare of the Tribes citizens, the utilization and conservation of the Tribes resources, and the acquisition of land and the development of new enterprises; and

WHEREAS, the access to timely surveying is essential for many programs and developments for us and other Olympic Peninsula Tribes; and

WHEREAS, there is a \$500,000 backlog of survey needs among the Olympic Peninsula Tribes; and

WHEREAS, there is an opportunity for a survey office to be relocated to the Olympic Peninsula area;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribe requests the Superintendent of the Olympic Peninsula Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs to actively seek the establishment of a survey office in the Aberdeen/Hoquiam office.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Superintendent be requested to seek additional funding to accomplish this establishment/relocation of a survey office to insure that existing programs are not adversely impacted.
