

SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBE

RESOLUTION NO: 87-14

Whereas; the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the governing body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the constitution and by-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the general body and the secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

Whereas; the Squaxin Island Tribe manages reservation and Tribally owned terrestrial and aquatic lands and the associated waters in a manner intended to balance benefits to all Tribal members, including renewable resource production, environmental protection, and revenue production; and


Whereas; aquaculture has demonstrated its economic viability as a beneficial renewable resource activity; and

Whereas; it is in the best interest of the Tribe to support the general welfare of its members through provision and utilization of its available resources;


It is hereby resolved that: the Squaxin Island Tribe endorses and supports the Aquaculture Committee goal of investigating the establishing private aquaculture ventures.
