Resolution No. 87-20 of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the governing body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is responsible to insure effective, quality law enforcement on reservation lands; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council realizes that there is a law enforcement hiatus on the reservation pertaining to non-Indian violators; and


WHEREAS, the Council deems it necessary to request that the Mason County Sheriff exercise jurisdiction over non-Indian persons on the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation, to fill the gap that exists, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council hereby requests that the Mason County Sheriff exercise jurisdiction and enforce applicable state and county laws to govern the conduct, of those non-Indian persons within the exterior boundaries of the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation, not covered by tribal jurisdiction.


