WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted with the overall care and development of its members; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is intent upon helping provide Tribal Members, and their families with every opportunity for growth and development; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council recognizes the importance of prevention of alcohol and drug abuse in the realization of the potential of Tribal members and their children.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does herein authorize the submission of the proposal for an Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention Grant for Native American youth; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council does hereby authorize the Tribal Chairman or Tribal Manager to act as the official Tribal representative for this grant, with full authority to negotiate and execute all grant documents, and amendments thereto and this authority shall be for the duration of the grant.
