WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has been entrusted to provide for the social, health and economic well-being of the Squaxin Island Tribal Citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has established a Tribal Coordinating Committee pursuant to the passage of the Omnibus Drug Bill; and

WHEREAS, the Coordinating Committee has developed a Tribal Action Plan within the time frame established by the Indian Health Service; and


WHEREAS, the cost for development of the Tribal Action Plan was borne by existing Federal Grants and Contracts in the hopes that reimbursement would be possible at a later date; and


WHEREAS, there is an opportunity to seek funds for Tribal Action Plan development.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Council directs the Tribal Manager to prepare and submit an application for funds to reimburse the costs incurred by the Tribe in the development of the Tribal Action Plan.
