WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior of July 8, 1965, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe recognizes the need to enhance and strengthen the development of its human and natural resources; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe finds it necessary for the overall social and economic development of the Tribal government to strengthen its Enterprises planning and management capabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe encourages economic development of the reservation and supports community goals for achieving self-determination as a nation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Tribal Council proposes to administer a Multi-year FY 88 Financial Assistance for Native American Project, coordinated with current Tribal community and economic development efforts; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The Squaxin Tribal Council hereby requests the ANA provide funding for the Squaxin FY 88 project as outlined in the enclosed proposal.
