SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of Interior on July 8, 1965, and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is eligible and authorized under P.L. 93-638 to contract for Bureau of Indian Affairs services for the benefit of the Squaxin Island Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council wishes to conduct the following program: Fisheries Sampling Project under contract as authorized by P.L. 93-638: and

WHEREAS, Title 25, Code of Federal Reglulations; at Chapter 271.18 requires the Tribe to request the contracts by Resolution and that the Resolution so passed must meet the provisions of the regulations cited herein.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that contracts for the following program: Fisheries Management to be entered into with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, to begin October 1, 1988 and continue through September 30, 1989.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council requests that this contract include BIA-18 Law Enforcement Services, 25 CFR 11.304 and 11.205 Minimum Standards for Police Programs, Application of Federal Criminal Laws, Law Enforcement Standards, Title 18 USC and 68 BIAM.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council and the Tribal Enforcement Division, of which Fisheries Enforcement is a part, understands that the fisheries enforcement are responsible for only those duties related to the enforcement of Tribal fishing ordinances and the protection of fisheries related resources.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Squaxin Island Tribal Council Chairman, or in the absence of the Chairman, the Vice-Chairman is authorized to negotiate and execute the contracts and any amendments thereof on behalf of the contractor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the contract must be reviewed and

approved by the Squaxin Island Tribal Council prior to execution. Modifications need not be reviewed by the Squaxin Island Tribal Council provided that such authorization does not exceed the specific intent, terms and objectives of the aforementioned documents and/or activity and is negotiated and executed in compliance with all applicable Tribal, Federal and other ordinances, laws, regulations, policies and procedures but must be signed by the Chairman or Vice-Chairman.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the authorization of the Squaxin Island Tribal Council Chairman and Vice-Chairman to negotiate and execute contracts for the purpose of programs under the Resolution shall expire September 30, 1989.

CERTIFICATION
