**RESOLUTION NO. 88 - 44
OF THE
SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the governing body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council has the responsibility to protect the tribal fishing resource, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council adopted a revised fishing ordinance in October 1986, by virtue of Resolution No. 86-45; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council, to best protect that resource, finds it necessary and appropriate to amend or revise the ordinance for the purpose of sound management;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council hereby adopts the attached Title 3, Fishing Code, revised July 25, 1988, to become effective immediately.
