RESOLUTION NO. 88-50 of the SQUAXIN ISLAND TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe is a member of the Puget Sound Health Board whose primary purpose is to make known the health needs of the Puget Sound member tribes - to impact the decision making process of the Indian Health Service and the United States Congress in determining funding packages and establishing priorities for delivery of services to the Indian Tribes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council hereby appoints the following as tribal delegates to the Puget Sound Health Board:




