WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribal Council is the Governing Body of the Squaxin Island Tribe of Indians by the authority of the Constitution and By-laws of the Squaxin Island Tribe, as approved and adopted by the General Body and the Secretary of the Interior on July 8, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe desires to obtain satisfactory water supply and adequate waste disposal facilities for Indians of the Squaxin Island Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Squaxin Island Tribe requested assistance from the Indian Health Service under Public Law 86-121 in the construction, installation, and/or rehabilitation of water supply and sewage disposal facilities for Indians on the Squaxin Island Indian Reservation; and


WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service desires to assist in the installation of water supply and sewage disposal facilities for Indians on the Squaxin Island Reservation.




